Tall Tales of Govanhill

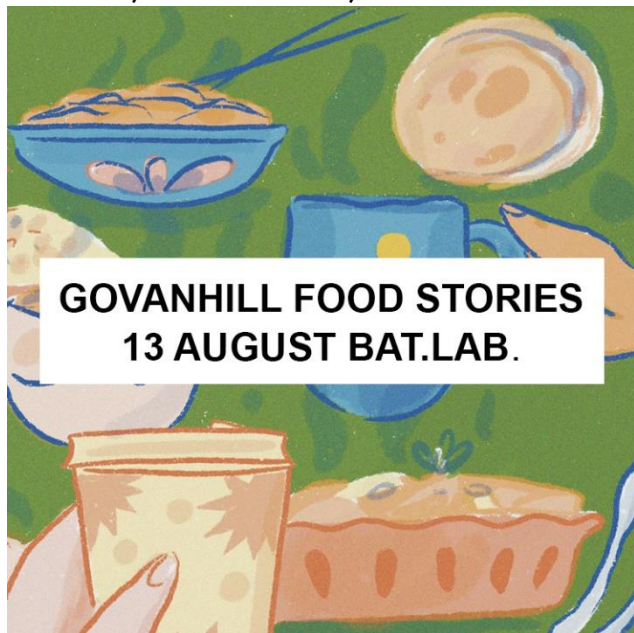
Wed, 10 August, 6–8pm, Bee's Knees Cafe
